## Notes of 1963

### Our Nation

- Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip arrived in Australia for a visit to all states and to attend Canberra's jubilee celebrations.
- Lifeline, Australia's first telephone counselling service, was founded in Sydney by the Central Methodist Mission.

### Our State

- Comalco began full-scale mining of bauxite at Weipa on Cape York Peninsula.
- Townsville's bulk sugar terminal, containing 78,000 tonnes of raw sugar, caught fire and burned for five days.
- Moura open-cut coalfield began large-scale production.

### Our Capital City

- Cyclone Annie caused damage at beach resorts north of Brisbane, killing two people.

### Our Neighbourhood, Our School

- Head Teacher purchased revolving arm chair and cushion for his office £14/10/-.
- Some timber desks and forms replaced with modern type dual desks and seats.
- Representations made to Minister for Works and Housing for the provision of internal steps from first floor to top floor.
- Head Teacher requested one metal filing cabinet because there was no cabinet to lock up school records. All these records were stored in a press that could not be locked.
- Male and Female staff rooms each received an electric urn and a power point. Previously water was boiled on a gas ring.
- District Inspector reported that there was an urgent need to remove writings and marks which disfigured the walls and partitions of girls' toilets - a sharp instrument had been used. A reply was received that this was not recommended as the walls had been painted in 1961.

**Our Nation**

- Destroyer HMAS Voyager sank after being cut in two by the aircraft carrier HMAS Melbourne in a collision off Jervis Bay; 82 lives lost.
- Australia's first national daily newspaper, *The Australian*, began publication in Canberra.
- The Beatles made an Australian concert tour.
- Englishman Donald Campbell broke the world wheel-driven land speed record on Lake Eyre in the Bluebird on 17 July, and the world water speed record at Lake Dumbleyung, WA, in the hydroplane Bluebird during Dec.

**Our State**


- Opening of the Moonie-to-Brisbane oil pipeline marked the beginning of production on Australia's first commercial oilfield.
- Mount Isa Mines shut down its copper smelter because of dispute.
- Qld government declared a State of Emergency in an attempt to end the Mt Isa dispute.

**Our Capital City**

- The Beatles performed in Brisbane.
- Brisbane was linked to Australia's first commercial oil field at Moonie.
- The Municipal Markets at Roma Street and the Brisbane Fruit and Produce Exchange in Turbot Street ceased trading.
- Bridge to Bribie Island was completed.

**Our Neighbourhood, Our School**

- Dead limbs were cut from the 13 trees in the school playground - 5 Moreton Bay figs, 2 camphor laurels and 6 palm trees.
- Lighting in the Infants building was a concern. A jacaranda tree was lopped but did not relieve the problem of lighting especially in the end room (Miss Arena's present 2001 classroom) - "single light in this room is far from satisfactory and children's eyesight is suffering". NFSS Committee had started requesting lighting in 1952. Four fluorescents were installed by October 1964.

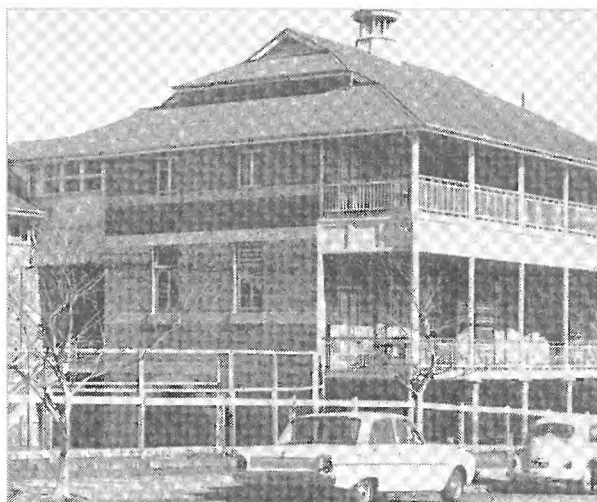

### **Our Nation**

- Royal Australian Mint opened in Canberra by Prince Philip and began producing the first Australian-made decimal coins.
- First drawing of the birthday lottery to determine those eligible for National Service training.
- Menzies announced the government's decision to send a combat force to Vietnam following a request from Saigon for more military aid.

### **Our State**

- Police at Mt Isa were given the power to arrest without warrant and ban any person aiding the strike.
- Mt Isa Mines suspended all operations.

### **Our Capital City**

- Arnott's Biscuit Company celebrated 100 years of business.

### **Our Neighbourhood, Our School**

- Permission sought from the Dept of Education to build a swimming pool. The following P&C members enabled the building of the pool to proceed by standing as Trustees and Guarantors: Sam Ramsden (MLA), Harold Crawford OBE (Alderman), Fred Windsor (P&C President). Guarantors: F. Oswell (also the architect), Mrs F. Rayner, C. Cuthbertson, J. Eckert, late D. Garven (in 1976), B. Grimish, B. Oxlade, R. Little.

## Notes of 1966

### Our Nation

- Sir Robert Menzies retired after a record 16 years as Prime Minister; Harold Holt replaced him.
- Decimal currency introduced.
- Prime Minister Holt announced a trebling of Australian forces in Vietnam, including 1 500 National Servicemen.
- Australian commitment in Vietnam increased to 6 300 men, with an additional 12 tanks, two minesweepers and eight bombers.
- OTC opened its first satellite communications earth station at Carnarvon, WA.
- Miniskirts and pantyhose came into fashion.

### Our State

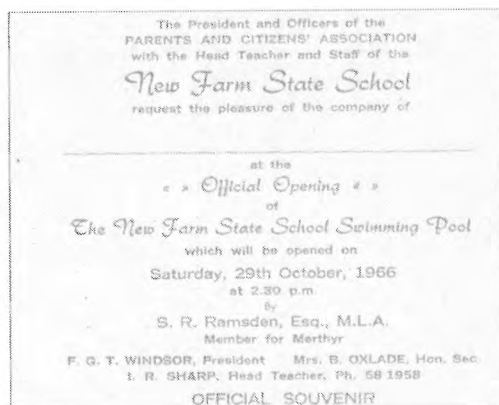
- An Ansett-ANA Viscount 800 crashed near Winton, with a loss of 24 lives.
- Provisions excluding Aborigines from Federal and Qld rural awards were replaced by a "slow workers'" clause.

### Our Capital City

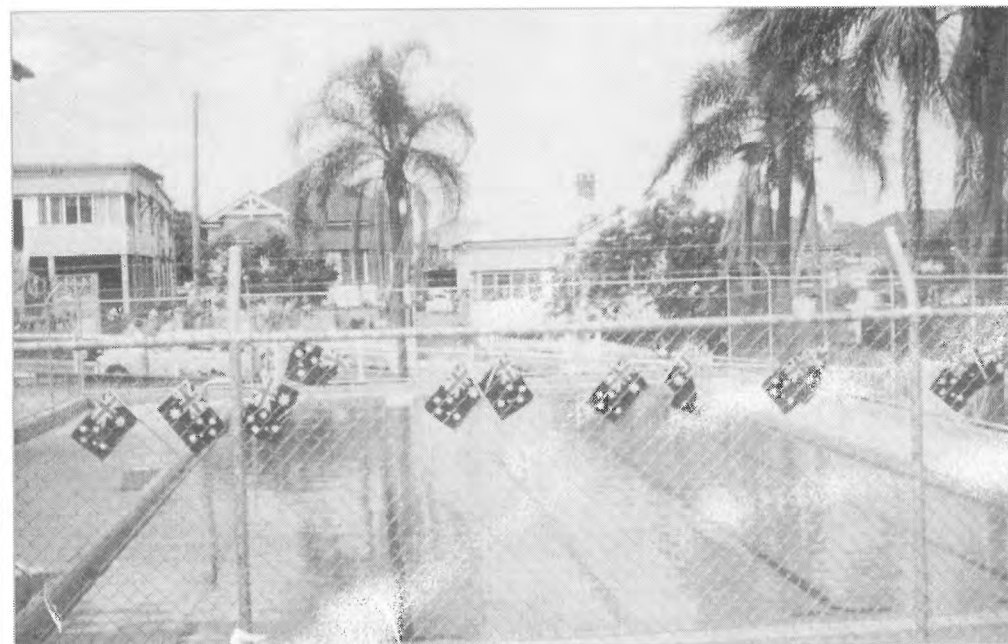
- Anti-conscription rally against service in Vietnam resulted in 26 arrests

### Our Nation

- National campaign of immunisation against poliomyelitis with Sabine oral vaccine began.
- Postcode system introduced.
- Prime Minister Holt announced that Australia would increase its military aid to South Vietnam by another battalion and support groups.
- Prime Minister Harold Holt disappeared in the surf at Cheviot Beach, Portsea, Vic.
- Current affairs program "This Day Tonight" began on ABC TV.

### Our State

- Police arrested 114 demonstrators in Brisbane protesting against changes in the law governing street marches.

### Our Capital City

- Fierce conservation battle over an application to take supplies of lime from Great Barrier Reef's Ellison Reef.

### Our Neighbourhood, Our School

- Beginners' swimming classes held on Saturday mornings.
- Filtration and Gas Chlorination System were considered for the swimming pool.

## Notes of 1968

### Our Nation

- Australia's first liver transplant performed at Sydney Hospital by a medical team headed by A.G.R. Sheil.
- Mounted police charged a crowd of about 1 500 anti-Vietnam War demonstrators outside the US Consulate in Melbourne; more than 45 arrested.
- Australia's first heart-transplant operation performed by Dr Harry Windsor at St Vincent's Hospital, Sydney.

### Our State

- Following the death of Qld Premier Jack Pizzey, Liberal leader Gordon Chalk temporarily took over the Premiership.
- Johannes Bjelke-Petersen, elected unopposed as Country Party leader in Qld, replaced Chalk as Premier.

### Our Neighbourhood, Our School

- Swimming Pool: Toilets installed in dressing sheds at a cost of \$48. Plans for filtration plant submitted but the Dept did not approve gas type filtration plant. Request for lights around the pool was submitted. Discussions between Committee and Dept continued. Ten Guarantors agreed to continue as Guarantors; need to borrow approx \$4,000 to pay for filtration plant and installation.



### David Mitchell attended NFSS 1968 to 1970.

I was the music monitor and played the Tijuana brass on a reel to reel tape recorder to assemble the students and march them in. We also assembled a microphone and speakers so that the assembly could be addressed.

On occasions, with great ceremony, a single speaker in a huge grey box was plugged into the

wall and a crackly distorted ABC program played. On very rare occasions we saw a television program in the large meeting room in the wing overlooking the playground. We had Boxing on the tennis court under the supervision of Graeme Gardiner and I remember a boxing display at the school fete in which I made another pupil's nose bleed.

## Notes of 1969

### Our Nation

- Thousands demonstrated in Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Canberra and Adelaide against America and the war in Vietnam.
- Twelve-sided cupro-nickel 50-cent piece replaced the round silver coin.
- Australia's steam train era ended with the last journey of loco 3801 between Sydney and Goulburn.
- First women's liberation groups formed in Sydney and Adelaide.

### Our State

- With the opening of the pipeline from Roma, Brisbane became the first Australian capital to receive a natural gas supply.
- Bjelke-Petersen government re-elected in Qld.

### Our Capital City

- Tramway service was discontinued in April and replaced by buses. The last tram No. 544 ran from the Valley to Milton depot.

### Our Nation

- *Indian Pacific* train made its inaugural transcontinental journey.
- More than 70 000 people, led by federal MP Jim Cairns, marched in Vietnam "moratorium" rallies held in capital cities.
- Further Vietnam moratorium rallies held in capital cities throughout Australia; 200 marchers arrested in Sydney, 100 in Adelaide.
- Australia's withdrawal of troops from Vietnam began with the return of the 8th Battalion, which was not replaced.
- Pope Paul VI, the first Pope to visit Australia, arrived in Sydney.
- "Meals on Wheels" service was introduced.

### Our State

- Cyclone *Ada* caused millions of dollars damage to Qld's Great Barrier Reef holiday islands. Thirteen lives were lost. The cyclone prompted the Bureau of Meteorology to conduct cyclone preparedness education programs. Later the same year, Qld suffered a disastrous series of summer floods along their coastline.

I have very fond memories of New Farm State School. To this day, I maintain that the support and education given to me at the school prepared me for secondary and tertiary achievements and also for life.

I remember my first day. I had barely turned five and my mother walked me to the school. My older brother David was already attending the school. I was so excited in my new crisp uniform, with my new pencils and port. There were so many other children to play with too. Everything seemed great until we filed into the grade one class room and my Mother had to say good-bye. I had assumed that Mum would be staying with me - I was very upset and cried and cried. My mother was upset too, but knew she had to go. I think I spent most of the morning sobbing and trying to sing nursery rhymes in between the sobs. It was the kindness shown to me by my teacher, Mrs Michels, that convinced me that I would be alright and taught me a love for school and learning which is still with me today.

I remember listening to the radio, which was a big grey box brought into the classroom. A strange voice came crackling over the airways telling us it was ABC radio. A lot of our lessons

were over the radio coming from that big grey box.

I remember the smell and purple ink of handouts fresh from the Fordigraph machine (before photocopying).

In grade five, I was in a composite class with Mr Gardiner and Mrs Harris. They were both young and hip. Mrs Harris even wore mini skirts. They were very cool teachers even by today's standards!

However, some of my other favourite memories are of grade six and grade seven. In grade six we had the most wonderful teacher, Miss Warland. I thought she was marvellous. She introduced us to a world of classical art and music with a passion, which she passed onto me and is with me today. She also taught us to appreciate the abstract art of painters like Picasso and encourage us to express ourselves artistically. To this day, I am also passionate about art and paint whenever I get the chance.

shaped me for the rest of my life. My teacher was Miss Suttie, a prim proper lady, who had been teaching all her life. This was to be her final year as she retired that year. I felt privileged to have had her as a teacher of such foresight and caring for her students. The other grade

seven teacher was Mr Rhodes. He was fairly new to the school and we all thought he was rather handsome. His class (7B) seemed to spend a lot of time doing sports. We used to look out the window with envy and watch them on the basketball court and wonder why Australian poetry was so important. In hindsight, I am glad I had Miss Suttie as a teacher. She taught us so much in literature and history. Every morning we sang a hymn or recited a poem. I can still recite most of them today! At the time, as a grade seven, you don't appreciate the necessity of learning about the "3Rs". However Miss Suttie always reminded us that although we were the "big fish in the small pond" now, we were soon to become the "small fish in the big pond" once we hit secondary school. She was right. The knowledge I learnt that year has served me well all my life, and prepared us extremely well for high school.

I remember to this day, all having to line up next to her desk after swimming so that she could put murine drops in our eyes to take the sting of the chlorine out. She cared that much. In grade seven I was also the bell ringer, a job shared with Ingrid Tall and Suzan Millward. It was a great privilege and we did it proudly. We were also responsible for playing the record of "God Save the Queen" at precisely the right moment for morning parade.

In grade seven, I was awarded with a gift voucher for \$50.00, which at the time seemed like such a lot of money! It was one of the proudest days of my life. I still have the books I bought with the money to this day.

New Farm State School was an extraordinary school. The seven years I spent there formed the basis of the rest of my life.

I wish New Farm State School all the best for the future.

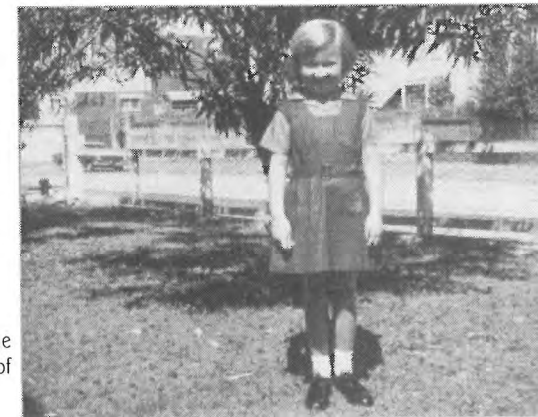

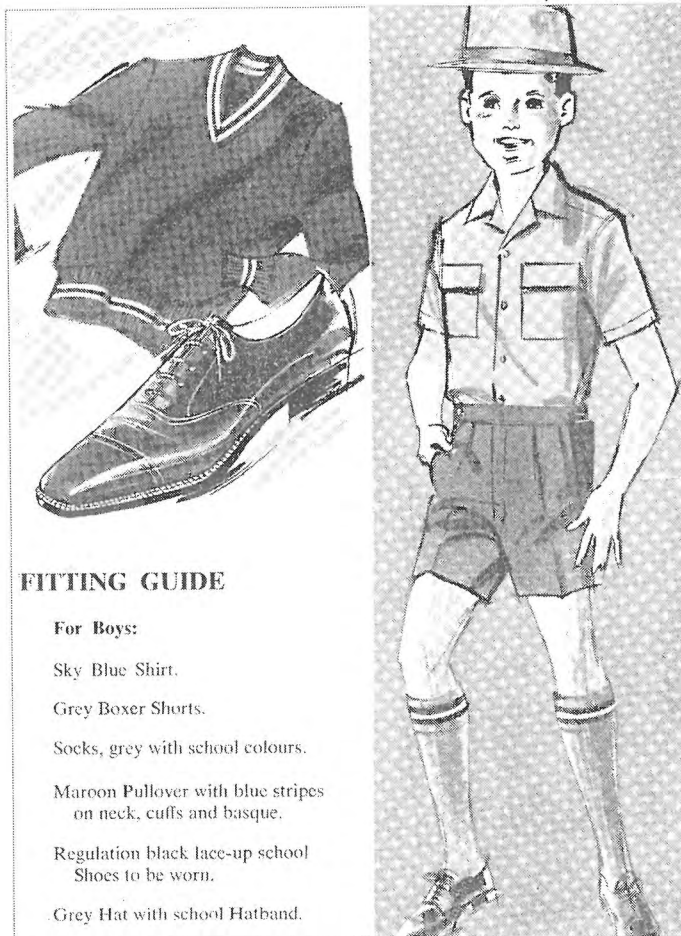

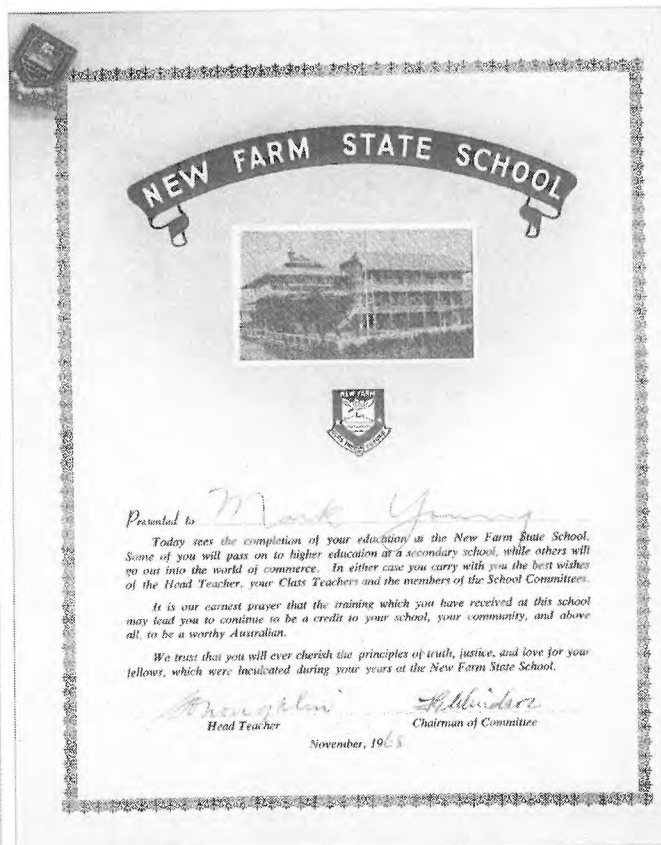

- Control of Moreton Island was transferred to the Brisbane City Council.

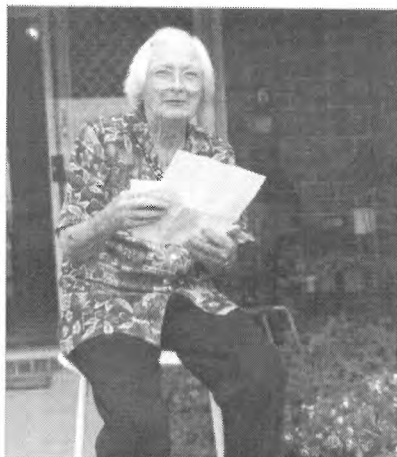

I served in the Qld Education Department for 42 years and no portion of my career was more rewarding or satisfying than the time I spent at NFSS.

For the whole 16 years, I was extremely fortunate to receive the complete support of hardworking and co-operative P&C Committees. Initially their fund-raising efforts provided many improvements and much-needed equipment, but their contributions to the welfare of the school were especially significant during the years when NFSS was included in the Special Program Schools Scheme. Those were indeed challenging years when a great number of improvements were carried out to the school buildings and grounds.

These improvements included carpets and teaching aids, landscaping of unattractive parts of the school grounds, provision of cricket practice nets, renovation of the basketball/tennis court, construction of the extremely popular adventure playground and the introduction of the instrumental music program.

An extremely pleasing feature throughout all of this was the excellent teamwork that existed between an enthusiastic P&C Association and a staff with a most professional attitude.

During the whole of my stay at NFSS, I was extremely fortunate to have the support of a truly top quality staff. Inspectors' annual reports regularly commented on the enthusiasm, dedication and energy of the staff, and the excellent example set by the senior teachers. The staff (including the Specialist teachers and aides) were always proud of the excellent tone throughout the school - a tone which reflected the professionalism of the teachers and their sympathetic approach to the children.

To my mind the special features of the school were the fine rapport between teachers and teachers, as well as teachers and pupils; the high quality performance and dedication of

staff members; and the courtesy and respectful attitudes of the scholars.

During my years at NFSS, the Pre-School was established. The benefits of the year spent there by pupils before coming to the "big school" were obvious and my comments concerning the quality of the staff at the primary school also apply to the teachers-in-charge of the Pre-School and their aides.

Of great benefit to the school was the Education Department's policy of maintaining a stable staff. Transfers were minimised, with the result that there was always a strong core of experienced teachers with a thorough knowledge of the school and the backgrounds of the pupils.

This was very important because many of the pupils came from a migrant background but they were able to move into the routine of the school without problems. The children were friendly but respectful and showed appreciation of the teachers' efforts on their behalf and were a delight to work with. There were very few serious disciplinary problems at NFSS.

An innovation was the introduction of Italian Language classes in the late 1970s. To facilitate the program, language books worth \$1000 were donated by local Italian businessmen and the Italian government. These were the first Italian classes conducted in a Queensland State Primary School.

NFSS was the last school at which I served during my 42 year teaching career. I have always been grateful that I had the privilege to be Principal of such a challenging yet interesting and rewarding school.
