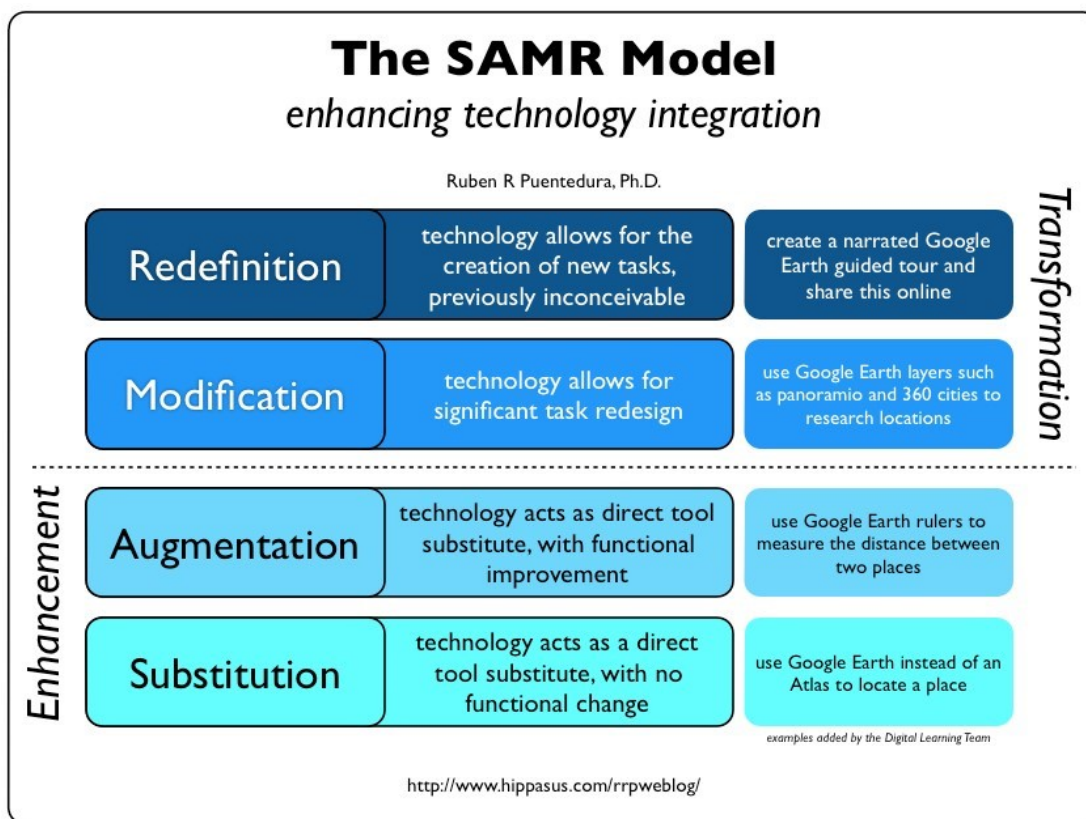

Our 2022 AIP focuses on aligning the school's Digital Technologies focus with Curriculum delivery, teacher pedagogy and student engagement and extension programs. With the extension of BYO Ipad to Year 3-6, we have also increased our technology support for teachers, students and families. This support includes the coaching and professional learning opportunities delivered by our Innovation Coach and our Technology Personnel.

Our initiatives include

- **Innovation – Develop creative, curious and digitally confident students.** In 2022, we will continue to strengthen our BYO Ipad program and extend our systemic planning and supports across the school.
- Developing a whole school Digital Technology Plan.
- Extending our technology assistant support for students and families in our BYO Ipad program Years 3,4, 5 and 6.
- Using and integrating a range of technologies to improve teacher knowledge and skills, pedagogy, differentiation and deep content connections. The staff will continue to be supported through our Professional Learning Community, ongoing Professional Development and sharing of best practice and latest research.
- Providing Digital Citizenship professional learning sessions for students, teachers and parents.
- Expanding use of digital resources and systems through our Library personnel and system.
